FURNISS CEMETERY
Mt. Vernon Election District No. 5

General Location: on Rte. 362 (Mt. Vernon Rd.) on the North side in the rear of John Wesley Church up a private road on the west side of churchyard.

Exact Location: West of the Town of Princess Anne on Rte 362 5 2/10s miles from the intersection of U.S. Rte. 13 and MD Rte. 362 to the John Wesley Methodist Church, located on the north side of Mt. Vernon Road proceeding North up a private dirt road on the West side of the church a distance of about 375 feet to a point; then West a distance of about 25 feet to a small cemetery located in the woods.

75 degrees 46' 40" West Long.
